Reminder – All weather footwear policy

Now that winter and the wet weather is fast approaching please make sure you are aware of the footwear policy for our All Weather Pitches.

- Up to and including the U10s, Clean e.g. mud-free astroturf boots/trainers can be worn by players in both dry and wet conditions. However, please note that should a player decide to wear astroturf boots/trainers in wet conditions, which remains in the view of the trustees as unsuitable, this is at their own risk.
- ALL teams at under 11 and over the current boot policy will apply at all times.

Please note the only exception is if the pitch has been subject to heavy rain or extreme wet conditions there may be occasions when astroturf boots/trainers will not be permitted at all, irrespective of age group.

The footwear policy is not just player related, it applies to all managers, coaches, assistant coaches, match officials and parents that enter the All Weather Pitch this is irrespective of age group and therefore the policy including use of Astroturf boots/ trainers only in dry conditions must be observed.

There is no reason for non-compliance of the footwear policy. The club have loan boots which are available in a range of all sizes for members and non-members to wear.

The Trustees will be undertaking random checks throughout the season and any team found not to be enforcing the policy will be asked to leave the pitch – *The Trustees also reserve the right to suspend teams from using the All Weather Pitches in the event of not upholding the footwear policy* – This is something we do not want to happen!
